OVERVIEW

This course on "Scuba and Society" provides students with an opportunity to study adventure tourism and eco-tourism organizations in **Belize** with the goal of better understanding how to develop sustainable tourism practices and how to mitigate conflicts between tourism organizations and local cultures. Students will benefit from the interdisciplinary approach of this course to build proficiency in scuba diving and to analyze the adventure- and eco-tourism industries (which include scuba) as a complicated but integral part of the international economy.
