All 291/491 students must complete laboratory safety training before beginning research. There are two parts to training:

- Part I: Online Environmental Health and Safety training. Proof of completion must accompany this form every semester before you can register.
- Part II: Lab Specific, is completed with your research supervisor in your lab. This form must be turned in by the 10th class day the first semester of research. Students returning to the same lab do not need to repeat the training.

NO CREDIT or grade will be given unless both safety forms are signed and returned. Printed names and UIN must be legible on all forms.

Writing requirement: At the end of each semester, every BIOL 291/491 student is expected to submit a written report that is first reviewed by their faculty mentor. This requirement does **NOT** make BIOL 291/491 a writing intensive course. There are multiple options for completing the writing requirement:

- Option 1: Research Summary
- Option 2: Oral or Poster Presentation at scientific meeting
- Option 3: Poster Presentation for Biology's poster competition (Spring only)
- Option 4: Final BIOL 495 or 491W manuscript
- Option 5: Research Scholar's Thesis

Details for each of these options can be found on Biology's Undergraduate Research Page. Circle the writing option you plan on completing. You can decide to change your option at any time. Submissions for graduating seniors will be due the day after finals. For all other students, reports are due the first Monday following finals week.
