### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

#### Research

Multidisciplinary experience for freshmen and sophomore students to learn about the scientific method in research and to develop their global competencies, while engaging in an Intro. to Research course in Mexico. Participate in many hands-on technical activities at places like the Yucatán Scientific & Technological Park.

### Collaboration

Students will join an online learning community, form a team of both A&M and Yucatán students, and **develop a research proposal** on a research problem identified while in Yucatán.

### **Cultural Activities**

Visit various **cultural sites** in Yucatán such as Chichen Itza and Uxmal archeological zones, cenotes, and other beauties from the Maya World, while living with a **host family.** 

### **A&M Faculty-Led**

Students in the College of Arts and Sciences will enroll in ANTH 291-140: Research (1-credit), taught by Dr. Heather Thakar, Assistant Professor in the Department of Anthropology, and Curator of Anthropology Research Collections.
